Set up may begin at 7:00 a.m. Saturday morning. Vendors must be set up and in place by 10:00 a.m. and may not pack up until 6:00 p.m.

Participants are responsible for their own tables, tents, and signage. Booths with water and power must bring own hoses & extension cords.

Due to pedestrian traffic, no vehicles will be allowed in the festival area during festival hours.
