## Mandatory Guidelines for Competitors

### Competitors Should Concentrate on:

- Required primary ingredient must be **crab meat** (no imitation crab meat).
- All stews must be cooked the same morning as the competition and transported sanitarly to the event site. **All stews must be delivered hot between 10:30- 11am.** Event site: Purple Pickle (look for YMCA tents)
- Each entry must provide 1 gallon of the stew to be donated to the YMCA to sell samples for the people's choice competition. All proceeds will be given to the McIntosh YMCA.

### Competitors Should Avoid:

- Identifying personal or business affiliation until judging is complete

### Competition Procedures:

- Volunteers will receive stews between 10:30 – 11:00am the morning of the event.
- Volunteers will organize the stews in an anonymous manner (temp 165). Each stew will be assigned a number and a ticket jar will be placed in front of each entry.
- Volunteers will begin selling samples at 11:30 a price of \$5 per person.
- Stews will be displayed in the crock pot (temp of 165 degrees) during the competition.
- Judging for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will begin at 11am.
- People's choice tasting will begin at 11:30 and end at 1:30pm. During this time, the YMCA will provide small plastic cups and spoons for individuals who purchase a people's choice ticket. This allows individuals to sample each of the stews once and place their ticket in the jar for the best stew. These tickets will be tallied to determine who received the most tickets and is the People's choice winner
- **All crock pots must be picked up by 2pm.**
